

ADDITION & SUBTRACTION

TENS AND ONES

Addition

When we add the tens and ones separately, sometimes we end up with more than ten ones.

For example, to add $45 + 38$, we add $40 + 30$ and $5 + 8$.

$40 + 30$ is 70, and $5 + 8$ is 13. So, $45 + 38$ is $70 + 13 = 83$.

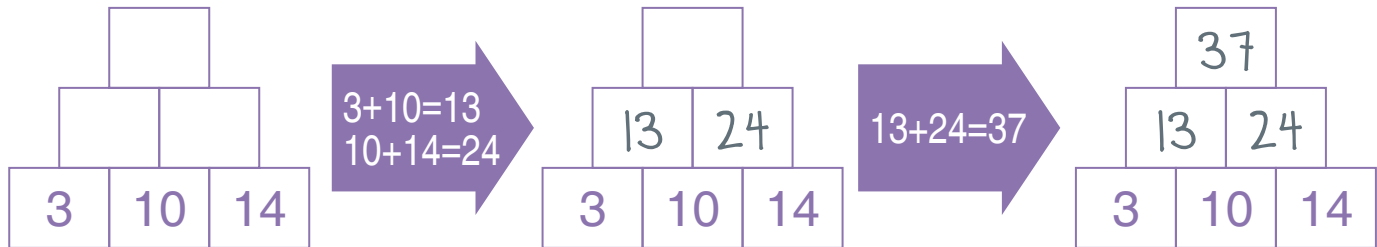

Add until you reach the top.

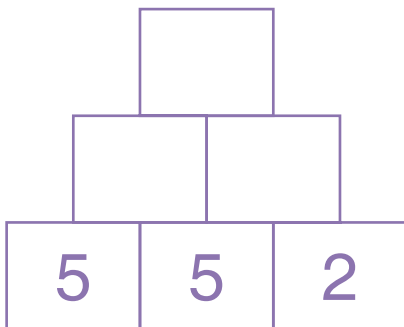
Sum Pyramids

In a Sum Pyramid, the number in each block is the sum of the two numbers below it.

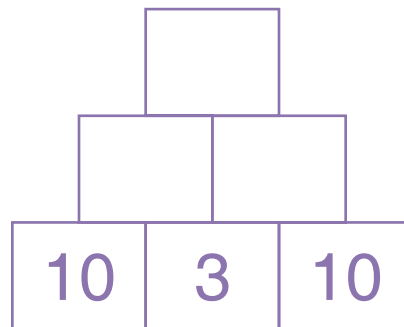
